The ceremony was held at the Eskişehir Chamber of Commerce on Wednesday, 12 May 2010 with the participation of Harun Karacan, the President of Eskişehir Chamber of Commerce and Hakan Ateş, the CEO of the DenizBank Financial Services Group. Option of Long Term Maturities

Within the framework of the protocols, enterprises which are members of ECC and ECI will be able to benefit from "Capital Support Loan" with maturities up to 72 months and "Equal Installment" loans with maturities up to 36 months from DenizBank offered with special interest rates. The interest rate for both credits shall be 1.25 %. The "Capital Support Loan" which is positioned as the first credit to offer long term finance option for the capital needs of

enterprises regarding purchase of goods and services makes it possible to cover their cash needs for up to 6 years of maturity by providing real estates as collaterals. Moreover, this new loan of DenizBank which offers special interest advantages for the members of ECC and ECI has a grace period of 3 months.

Hakan Ateş, the CEO of the DenizBank Financial Services Group evaluated the collaboration of the ECC and ECI by saying “Eskişehir is among the leading cities in Turkey with exports of approximately \$ 600 million in the fields of agriculture, industry and mining.
