In the scope of the project, it is also planned to arrange accessible tours for those with different disabilities in the Istanbul Biennial.

DenizBank's Accessible Art Partnership will be expanded with an aim to increase inclusivity and diversity in art production and participation through projects to be carried out in different art disciplines.
