

“Memory of Transformation” Exhibition By 3 Women Artists is open at Gallery Deniz

Curated by Dr. Gizem Pamukçu; composed of painting and statue works prepared by Ayşe Sultan Babayiğit, Ruhiye Onurel (ROŞ) and Deniz Say with recycled material and mixed techniques, the special exhibition is now open at Gallery Deniz, the culture and art space of DenizBank on the occasion of 8 March International Women’s Day.

Working with the mission of making culture and arts accessible to everyone, DenizBank is now hosting the **“Memory of Transformation”** exhibition which draws attention to the preservation of natural resources in its culture and art space Gallery Deniz. The selection which is composed of the works of three women artists working with the understanding of sustainable production consists of paintings and statues featuring recycled materials, natural forms and mixed techniques.

The mixed selection shaped with the shared sensitivity of the artists make the transformation processes the materials go through visible while offering an aesthetic lens into environmental awareness. With its narrative that reopens the questioning of production and consumption cycle, the “Memory of Transformation” remains open until **29 March Sunday** at Gallery Deniz.
